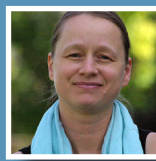

Tonya Feared for Her Life

Tonya's life seemed pretty normal up until three years ago: she was a happy mother of five, homeschooling her "little brood" every day in beautiful Southern California. Then little Hudson, number six, came along. Shortly afterwards Tonya got the flu, but this flu didn't go away. Several months later she got severe migrating joint pains throughout her body. Next she developed an extremely rapid heartbeat which required two medications, one to slow her heart down and one to inhibit her thyroid. At this point she feared for her life.



In her own words:

I was told by my naturopathic doctor that there was nothing they could do; it was either "kill" my thyroid with radioactive iodine or have it surgically removed, both very risky. I was so depressed, but somehow I was able to read. I read every book and

online article I could find on hyperthyroidism.

I learned that most thyroid disorders are autoimmune related, but I had tested negative for all thyroid autoimmune disorders. This was confusing, but I figured that since no one knew what was causing this, it wouldn't hurt to try treating myself as if I DID have one. I didn't care what anyone thought. I wanted to get well, and no one was giving me answers.

I stopped eating wheat the day I learned that "gluten can trigger autoimmune reactions." I haven't eaten any since. Then I started the GAPS diet, plus the Autoimmune Paleo elimination diet. My joint pains completely disappeared within two weeks. Then my thyroid labs started getting better and better with every trip to the endocrinologist. Before I knew it, I was off of all meds.

Then I saw a change in my family as they

*joined me on this diet. For one child in particular, it was dramatic, like night and day. I saw improvements in personality, behavior and health: dairy allergy was healed, growth of three sizes happened in one year, and a distended stomach completely disappeared. Although I've not reached my full healing yet, in many ways I feel better than ever. The answer for me, like many things in life, was simple but not easy. Simple because I just needed to eat real food that I prepared myself, foods that I get at **Steve Plog's Our Little Market**. But it was difficult because I had to change so many habits and had to learn to do without so many conveniences.*

At the beginning of this journey, I complained to God; why did He interrupt my life in this way? But then I realized how much this dietary change has helped my children. This was the "kick in the pants" that I needed to get my whole family well. Most of them hardly ever get sick anymore. How grateful I am.

Anyone who's been reading this Post for any length of time probably understands that, at the root of any degenerative health issue, there's probably a nutritional deficiency, or toxicity, or both. For Tonya, her problem was her thyroid; for another it may be something else, but the root cause is usually the same. Please know that we're here to help anyone we can and that includes YOU! And, again, we thank you for your ongoing support and prayers for this ministry. It's one that we feel, by God's grace, is making a difference, and we thank Him!
